(Benjamin) Frank Boehm, died Nov. 7 after a recent period of failing health.

He was 80 last January.

Frank, who lived in Haywood Knolls with his wife Chloe, was a founding member of our GM Alumni Club back in 1992, when he was activities vice president and served on the board three years.

He retired in 1988 from Chevrolet Engineering, in Michigan, moving to Hendersonville at that time. He was an active member of Living Savior Lutheran Church, serving as president of the congregation for some years and singing in the choir.

Frank was born in San Diego, attended a Lutheran high school in North Dakota, where he and Chloe met. After he served during World War

II in the Merchant Marine, he and Chloe married in 1946 and moved to Ann Arbor where he completed his degree and subsequently went to work for General Motors. The family later lived in Oak Park and Grosse Pointe Woods.

In addition to his wife, Frank is survived by daughters Carol Boehm of Hendersonville; Cynthis Wille of Oakton, VA; Kathleen Boehm of Harper Woods, MI; Ellen Anderson of Dowling, MI; son Dan of Seattle; a brother, Dan Boehm of San Jose, CA, four grandsons and two granddaughters.

A Memorial Service was held at the Groce Funeral Chapel on Long Shoals Road on November 10.
