Sally B. Seidel, age 71, of Hendersonville passed away Saturday, May 9th, 2015.

She was preceded in death by her mother, Dorothy R. Wisner and father, Robert Wade Biesecker who died while serving his country during WWII as a B17 pilot in 1944. He is interred in St. Avold, France.
